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Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) (07/21/2006)

Question or Issue:

Amendment 2 of the Inpatient Bed Purchase requires monitoring of bed availability. When the hospital census is 8 or less, unless otherwise contraindicated by the hospital contract, project admissions should be allowed. When prepurchased days are available and the census is over 8, a project admission is based on bed availability.

Precedence:

Approved System Oversight, July 7, 2006.

VI. Scope of Services, Subsections 1 and 2

Guidance or Actions:

Whenever a member of the participating CSB refers an individual qualified under the Reinvestment Project to a contact hospital, and one or more hospital refuses admission, the CSB staff member will e-mail or fax a summary of the events (not more than 1 or 2 paragraphs) to the project director not later than the next business day. The Summary should include but not limited to:

- (a) CSB Staff member' name and contact information
- (b) Date and time of referral
- (c) Hospital and Staff member's name
- (d) Reason for referral
- (e) Reason for refused admission
- (f) If an alternative admission date or time were given
- (g) Any untoward outcomes
- (h) How resolved

The Project Director will notify the Hospital Director of the event and conduct a review of the event.
